2.2 Become a Basic Income Guarantee pilot site

The Ontario Basic Income pilot project was launched in 2017. The City of London was not successful as a host City.

The pilot project was implemented in Hamilton, Brantford, Brant County, Lindsay and Thunder Bay and the surrounding area to test whether a basic income can better support vulnerable workers, improve health and education outcomes for people on low incomes, and help ensure that everyone shares in Ontario's economic growth.

On July 31, 2018, Minister MacLeod announced that the three-year \$150 million pilot project would be cancelled despite campaign assurances that it would continue if Premier Ford was elected.

The Basic Income project concluded on March 31, 2019.
